Overview & Quick Tips

TO ACHIEVE THE PRO CHEER LOOK FOR AUDITIONS

First... It's very important that you research "the look" of the team that you plan to audition for. You want to look like them, yet show off your unique-ness too. Print out pictures of dancers currently on the team that resemble your skin tone, hair color, eye color, etc. Then watch tutorials (like ours), meet with a makeup artist for help, work with one of our Sideline Prep Coaches by taking Sideline Attraction, etc. ... Also don't forget to check out the team's Sponsors – this could help lead you in the right direction! Maybe they have a preferred makeup artist and/or makeup companies.

Next, practice!! Master that look for yourself. Try different looks.... Smokey eye, natural, dramatic, etc. Also practice putting on lashes and figuring out which brand and style you like... (We LOVE ARDELL Demi Wispies!)

Finally, wear your "new" look to dance classes to ensure it withstands high intensity movement and sweat. Be sure to go outside and stand in the sun for a while to make sure you will be okay dancing on the field at a football game or appearance. Alright... Makeup and Tools

The below are listed in order of “appearance” in the tutorial:

Foundation

- Fenty foundation no.440
- Fenty highlight stick(under eye) no.420
- Banana setting powder to bake (works with most skin tones)
NOTE: Consult with a retail makeup specialist regarding the appropriate shade of foundation for you. Your neck and décolleté should always match your face! BLEND BLEND BLEND!

Eye color

- MAC Sketch – All over eyelid (full Smokey)
- MAC Sketch – Under eye (full Smokey)
- MAC Carbon – Waterline
- MAC Peach Luster – Brow bone brow highlight

Lashes – Ariel brand lash in 110

Blush /Contour/Highlight

- MAC Raizen – High cheek blush/apple of cheek
- MAC Sketch – Cheek contour
- Fenty Killawatt – Highlight, duo in Ginger
binge/Moscow mule brush across the T- Zone,
Temple and or high cheekbone.
Highlight is always optional for "Pop"

Lip

- MAC Vino lip pencil- lip liner
- MAC Yash nude Matte lip
- FENTY Gloss Bomb over top to blend

REMINDER: Don't forget to always set your makeup for long wear so you're good to go all day... for appearances, practice and games!

- Set the look with NYX "Dewy setting spray"
 - Or if you prefer a matte look, NYX "Matte setting spray"
